STURBRIDGE YARD SALE CENTRAL LOCATION INFORMATION

The Association will provide advertising and signage. You must adhere to the Sturbridge signage rules and regulations. For copies of these rules, please visit our website www.sturbridgehomeowners.com.

To assist yard sale participants, we have arranged a central location at the Sturbridge Plantation Park near the tennis courts. Please do not set up on the tennis courts!

You may bring your yard sale items to the area around the Sturbridge Park and/or Tennis Courts in the grassy areas. This location allows for less confusion relating to traffic, lack of advertising on certain streets, and safety issues due to visitor parking. This central location will also allow for those Sturbridge participants and neighbors to socialize, communicate, and get to know one another. This area also contains water fountains and bathrooms for your own convenience.

Visitors may park in the parking area.

You must provide all items which you may need: table, chairs, cash and change, umbrella, tent, drinks, snacks, etc. Please do not sale from the back of a wagon, truck, etc. from the parking lot.

You are responsible for clean-up of your central location.

Children may establish a Lemonade Stand. However, close parental supervision is required.

Sturbridge Homeowners' Association is not responsible for unattended children, lost/stolen items, injury or accidents on the playground area, or other unforeseen actions or events which may occur.

A charitable organization will be contacted to pick up unsold items. All unsold items must be boxed and contained and set on the sidewalk by the tennis courts by 12:30 PM on the day of the sale.
